We will build a new

MORE PEOPLE LIVING & WORKING IN THE CITY CENTRE

As part of the next phase of Northgate, we will bring investment into the city to provide more homes for people that want to live and work in Chester. We will also support projects to convert unused upper floor space (above the Rows) into homes and workspaces for rent.



CREATE A THRIVING ARTS, CULTURE & HERITAGE SCENE

We will make Chester known for having a vibrant visual arts scene by investing in a cultural programme and events like the new Chester Contemporary. Working with local people and organisations, we will bring international artists and new heritage experiences to our city.



REFRESH FOR THE NORTHGATE ARENA

Everyone has fond memories of times spent at the Northgate Arena. We'll invest in a renovation programme to bring the pool, sports and changing facilities back up to a decent standard. We'll even make sure the Whale gets a new coat of paint.

WHERE DOES YOUR COUNCIL TAX GO?

The Conservative government has failed to solve the national crisis in social care, so now around 60p of every £1 of your council tax is used to support vulnerable children and adults. This leaves just 40p to pay for roads, waste collection, street

cleaning, libraries, leisure centres, planning, grass cutting and everything else the council does.



ARE YOU PAYING MORE THAN EVERYONE ELSE?


