ORGANISING COMMUNITY CLEAN UPDAYS

WORKING FOR MORE HIGH SCHOOL **PLACES**

SOLVING PARKING ISSUES

DELIVER THE TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION

Redevelopment starts shortly and will be completed in 2024, including a community hub with public toilets, new retail units and a civic square with space for events. The councilowned development will be a huge improvement on what we have now after years of neglect under private owners.



FIGHTING FOR BETTER BUSES IN WINSFORD

Tory bus privatisation has failed communities, with Arriva cutting and running from Winsford and other towns. We'll continue to seek better operators to take over routes, and will work with the next Labour Government to bring in public control of buses so that residents have the services they need.



HELP AND SUPPORT WITH THE COST OF LIVING CRISIS

We will continue to fund support services for people who are struggling to make ends meet, and we will work together with community food groups to make life more affordable for people on low incomes, build stronger communities and reduce food waste.



TACKLING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR IN OUR TOWN

We will continue to work with the Police to tackle anti-social behaviour, including funding for community safety wardens and investing in CCTV in public places. We will also identify funding opportunities for new youth services, so that young people have more things to do in our town




INVEST IN OUTDOOR SPORTS AND LEISURE FACILITIES

WHERE DOES YOUR COUNCIL TAX GO?

centres, planning, grass cutting and everything else the council does.


Labour would launch a National Care Service to run alongside the NHS.
