TACKLING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

We will continue to work with the Police to tackle anti-social behaviour, including funding for community safety wardens and investing in CCTV in public places. We will also identify funding opportunities for new youth services, so that young people have things to do in our town.



PRIDE IN OUR TOWN CENTRE

Following the launch of Theatre Porto and the new bus interchange, we will continue with our plans to improve the town centre by modernising the Market Hall and converting the Flea Market into a multiuse event space. We will also continue to invest in green spaces, like the success of Whitby Park.



HELP AND SUPPORT WITH THE COST OF LIVING CRISIS

We will continue to fund support services for people who are struggling to make ends meet, and we will work together with community food groups to make life more affordable for people on low incomes, build stronger communities and reduce food waste.



COMMON SENSE ACTION TO STOP UNAUTHORISED ENCAMPMENTS

We will take action to secure sites which have commonly been used for unauthorised encampments, instead identifying better sites with appropriate facilities for travelling communities.



STANDING UP FOR WHITBY IT'S YOUR CHOICE ON THE HYDROGEN VILLAGE

The Government and Cadent recently proposed a trial to use hydrogen for heating and cooking in some homes in Whitby.

This is <u>NOT</u> a council decision. However, Labour councillors and our MP listened to local concerns and took action to represent your views to government and to Cadent.

Now, households that don't want to be part of the trial don't have to be anymore. These properties can opt out, they will keep their current appliances and remain on natural gas throughout the trial.

People who wish to join the trial are now able to choose to do so.

For the general safety and security of people in Whitby, Labour remains committed to the 5 practical tests we set out based on resident views.

We still think these must be met before the Government makes any decision to proceed with the trial:

- 1 Public vote No support, no tr
- 2 Price guarantee
- Energy prices must be same or cheaper **3 Safety framework**
- The HSE needs to state this trial is safe. **Green hydrogen**
- Hydrogen needs to be clean and green **5 Local jobs**
 - Any new jobs need to be for local people
